This event is CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC and open to REGISTERED TWINS AND THEIR FAMILIES ONLY. MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Due to demographic trends in contest participation by twins during previous years (some contests with enormous numbers of twins, and some contests with only two sets, one set or no sets at all), age groupings in many contests, mostly after the photo break, have been changed. Please look carefully for where YOUR age group is now found, and plan your attendance at the contests accordingly. We will plan so shift age groupings in the future as participation shifts.

The Welcome Wiener Roast and Children's Field Games will be located at Dodge Intermediate School, located on Ravenna Road across from the festival site. The cost of a hot dog dinner for registered twins is **FREE**. For non-twins there is a \$2 per person charge. Look for the signs!

There will be two portable restrooms located at the start (in the park area in front of the TDFC office) and at the end of the parade route for the benefit of those watching the "Double Take" Parade.

Preferred parking is available at Twinsburg High School and Dodge Intermediate School at a cost of \$3 per day for cars and \$5 per day for motor homes and buses. **FREE** shuttle transportation from the parking areas to the festival site is available on Saturday and Sunday, from open to close.

There will be **NO SMOKING** in any areas of the festival grounds as posted. In accordance with local fire regulations there will be absolutely **NO SMOKING** inside any of the tents erected on the festival site. This will be strictly enforced.

DOGS AND OTHER PETS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE FESTIVAL GROUNDS.

Anyone bringing a pet to the festival will not be allowed to bring the pet through the gate. The only exceptions are those animals (dogs) that are specifically trained to assist the physically challenged. To prevent any problems, **please do not bring your pets. They will not be allowed through the gate, and we don't suggest leaving them in a hot vehicle all day.**

The "Meeting Board", located in front of the Twins Days Souvenir Tent, will be available again this year for those who wish to contact twins or others they have met in the past.

VISA, MASTERCARD, and DISCOVER will be accepted for purchases at the official souvenir booth during the festival. Travelers checks, with proper identification, will also be accepted. Due to technical problems encountered in the past, **CREDIT CARDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR ANY TRANSACTIONS AT THE REGISTRATION BOOTH.** Only cash, personal checks, cashiers checks, travelers checks (with proper identification), and money orders will be accepted.
